



## BREAKDOWN OF UNI-CRAFT CORP. REMANUFACTURING SERVICES

The customer will be responsible for the shipment of the core (lift) to and from Uni-Craft Corp. Upon receiving the core (lift) the following will occur:

### PRELIMINARY REMAN INFORMATION

Before the return of the core, a pre-reman detailed list of wear parts will be sent to the customer. This will indicate the minimum mandatory parts that will be replaced and other services that will occur during the remanufacturing process. The customer will also have the option of indicating whether they need cylinder replacement or not. At this time all wear issues or known upgrades should be detailed, signed and returned to Uni-Craft Corp.

### INCOMING INSPECTION OF LIFT - "THE REMANUFACTURING AUDIT"

- Photograph incoming unit prior to audit
- Inspect for shipping damage
- Inspection of frames
- Inspection of integrity of arms
- Table top inspection
- Cylinders inspection
- Welds will be inspected for cracks and breaks
- A detailed Audit report with remanufacturing quote will be sent to customer as well as a list of recommended upgrades upon receiving the purchase order the remanufacturing process detailed below will occur.

### "THE REMANUFACTURING PROCESS"

#### CLEANING OF UNIT

- Power wash
- Degrease
- Scraping

#### DISASSEMBLY OF UNIT

- Disassembly of lifts for parts evaluation and log entry on remanufacturing inspection list

#### EVALUATION OF PARTS

- Determination of parts capabilities
- Controls and skirting
- Log all scrapped parts
- Log all replacement parts
